רַקֵּב n.[m.] rottenness, decay (always fig.);—**abs.**; appar. of ravages of worm, in fig.; **גֵּית יְהוּדָה**, in fig. Ho 5¹² (|| עֵשׂ), cf. Jb 13²⁸ (|| *id.*); elsewhere of decay of bones, *caries* (in fig.); **בְּעֵצָו** Hb 3¹⁶ Pr 12⁴, cstr. **עֵצֵי רַקֵּב** 14³⁰.

רַקֵּבֹתַי n.[m.] *id.*;—**עֵץ רַקֵּב** Jb 41¹⁹ *wood of rottenness*, = *rotten wood* (in fig.).

רָקַד vb. skip about (NH Pi. [רַקְחָה] vb. mix, or compound oil, ointment (perh. denom.; in this case √ meaning unknown; NH has **מִרְקַחַת** *ointment*; Ph. **רָקַח** either *spice-mixer* (Bloch) or *spice-douler* (Lzb); perh. akin to As. *rikku*, *spice*, Meissn^{suppl. 90}, cf. *rikké*, DI^{11W11620});—**Qal Impf.** 3 ms. **יִרְקַח** Ex 30³³; **Pt.** **יִרְקַח** v^{25,35}, **רוּ** 37²⁹ Ec 10¹; pl. cstr. **יִרְקַחִי** 1 Ch 9³⁰;—**mix, compound**, Ex 30³³ (P; **קָמָחוּ**, i.e. anything like the holy oil); **pt.** as subst. **יִרְקַחִי** 1 Ch 9³⁰ *compounders of the ointment*; as a professional name, *mixer, perfumer*, Ex 30^{25,35} 37²⁹ Ec 10¹. **Pu.** **Pt.** **מִרְקַחִים** 2 Ch 16¹⁴ *mixed as ointment*. **Hiph.** **Inf. abs.** **יִרְקַחְתָּ** Ez 24¹⁰ (|| **הִתָּם**), as Inv., *spice the spicing* (י), i.e. *spice* (the meat) well, but very dub., Krae prop. **יִרְקַחְתָּ** *empty out the broth*.

רַקְחָה n. m. ointment-maker, perfumer;—only in phr. **בְּנֵי־הַרְקַחִים** Ne 3⁸, i.e. one of the perfumers, i.e. of that guild.

רַקְחָה n. f. (female) ointment-maker, perfumer;—**אִמְּוֹת טַבְּחוֹת** 1 S 8¹³ (+ **טַבְּחוֹת**).

רַקְחָה n. [m.] perfumery;—**אִמְּוֹת טַבְּחוֹת** Is 57⁹ *thy perfumeries, unguents*.

מִרְקַחָה n. [m.] spice, perfume (of cheeks); pl. **מִרְקַחִים** Ct 5¹³ (v. also **מִנְדֵּל 3**).

מִרְקַחָה n. f. 1. ointment-pot, in which ointment is compounded, Jb 41²³ (fig.). 2. spice-seasoning (י); as acc. cogn. v. √ **Hiph.**

מִרְקַחָתַי n. f. 1. ointment-mixture. 2. ointment-pot (י);—1. **אֲבִי הַרְקַחִי** 1 Ch 9³⁰; **מִרְקַחָתַי** Ex 30²⁵. 2. **בְּמִי** 2 Ch 16¹⁴ *in an ointment-pot* (י), or as an ointment-mixture.

רַקַּם vb. variegate (NH *id.*; so Ar. رَكَم, Eth. Ḳṣṣ, cf. רַקַּם רַקְמָה *variegated cloth or skin*, Syr. رَكَمًا *freckles*);—**Qal Pt. act.** **רַקַּם**, as subst. *variegator, worker (weaver) in colours*, c. **ב** mater. Ex 38²³, **וְרַקַּם** *variegator's work* 26³⁶ 27¹⁵ 28³⁰ = 36³⁷ 38¹⁸ 39²⁹ (all P; all c. mater. exc. 28³⁰). **Pu.** **Pf.** 1 s. sf. **יִרְקַמְתִּי** ψ 139¹⁵ *I was skilfully wrought* (woven, || **סָבַךְ** v¹³).

רַקְמָה n. f. variegated stuff (woven or embroidered);—**אֲבִי הַרְקַמָּה** Ez 16¹⁸, **הָם** 26¹⁶; du. **הַרְקַמָּה** Ju 5³⁰; pl. **רַקְמָוֹת** ψ 45¹³;—(piece of) *variegated stuff*, Ju 5³⁰, for garments Ez 16^{10,13} 27^{16,21} ψ 45¹⁵; explicitly, **רַקְמָה** Ez 16¹⁸ 26¹⁶; **רַקְמָה** appar. = *variegated work* 27⁷; fig. of variegated plumage 17³; of variegated stone 1 Ch 29².

[רַקַּע] vb. beat, stamp, beat out, spread out (NH *id.*; Hiph., Aram. **רָקַע** Aph., both *spread out*, and deriv.; Syr. رَكَع *press down* (Lk 6³⁸ ☩), *spread out*, also *consolidate*; Ar. رَكَع, *patch, put on a patch, repair*, cf. Chr.-Pal. رَكَع *patch*, رَكَع *swaddling-bands*, Schwally^{1401, 91}; Ph. **מִרְקַע** *platter, or bowl, of gold* CIS^{1, 90, 1});—**Qal Impf.** 1 s. sf. **יִרְקַעַם** 2 S
