

MAIMONIDES' BIBLICAL EXEGESIS

DESCRIPTION: Maimonides' philological, literary and historical interpretations of Scripture in light of his rabbinic and philosophical sources, as well as the medieval Babylonian-Iberian *peshat* school. Exegetical goals of the *Guide*; selections from other Maimonidean writings. Biblical texts and topics: Genesis 1-5 (Account of Creation), anthropomorphic depictions of God, prophecy, derivation of *halakhah*, Job, Song of Songs.

REQUIREMENTS. Lectures are based on sources and readings (see bibliography, pp. 3 ff.) indicated on the syllabus below and must be prepared *prior* to class meetings. A research paper is due at the end of the semester. Please consult me to choose a topic (my e-mail: cohenm@yu.edu).
