

Instructions for Paper

The paper should be 10-12 pages, printed in a normal-sized font and double spaced; anything beyond that will not be corrected. It is due at the last meeting of the class. A brief proposal should be submitted for approval by the fifth meeting of the class.

With the exception of commentaries printed in the *מקראות גדולות*, full references must be given in footnotes following the rules of some recognized style sheet. All passages in Hebrew, Aramaic, etc. should be typed in Hebrew script or in some standard form of *scholarly* transliteration (Academy of the Hebrew Language, *Encyclopedia Judaica*, *JBL*, etc.). All foreign language passages must be accompanied by a "literal but literate" translation into English. Photocopies of all sources should be submitted together with the paper.

To find and print records of all articles dealing with Gen 1:1 in École Biblique CD ROM:

Left click:

1. École Biblique icon
2. magnifying glass icon
3. Search Type: Phrase
4. Books: All Books

Under "Search Query" type "Ge 1:1" Note that for this search-type the short abbreviation of the book name must be used:

Under école biblique livre, right click "X occurrences in X articles"

Left click:

1. Transfer hit(s) to Note File
2. Yes
3. Print icon

To find (נאדר) and כח used together in *piyyutim* and other early sources using the Ma'agarim CD ROM (the Historical Dictionary Project of the Academy of the Hebrew Language):

Double click *מאגרים* icon. Click *צירופים* and then *בחר ערכים*.

Type אדר in box. Double click [נפעל] אדר. Click *הוסף בינוני (פועל)* and then *הוסף*.

Delete אדר in box and type כוח. Double click *כוח (און, גבורה, תוקף)*. Click *הוסף* and then *אישור*.

Set distance between words at a number appropriate to your purpose. Click *מצא צירופים*, then *צפה בתוצאה*. Click *הבא* and *הקודם* to go back and forth in the list of attestations in context.

The date of each attestation is accompanied by a symbol explained on p. 25 of the manual.
